On May 20, 2015 an Omaha Police Officer was killed in the line of duty while serving a felony search warrant. Ofc. Kerrie Orozco had put off starting maternity leave until her premature baby girl born in February, could come home from the hospital. Just hours before bringing her daughter home and taking the long-awaited leave, Orozco was gunned down on the job by the suspect. Ofc. Kerrie Orozco was an outstanding Officer and community leader, working with youths in Omaha's most troubled areas. She leaves behind a husband, two step children and her new born baby.



Several NEII members participated in the funeral; performing casket guard, honor guard duty, and attending the funeral. Several members also rode with the Patriot Guard, who allowed us the honor of leading the procession.
